In August 2016, we recycled 91 tons of aluminum, cardboard, paper, scrap metals, plastics and glass.


Recycling these materials will save the following resources:

950 Mature Trees

Represents enough saved timber resources to produce 11,776,500 sheets of newspaper!

342 Cubic Yards of Landfill Airspace

Enough airspace to fulfill the annual municipal waste disposal needs for 439 people!



198,022 kWh of Electricity

Enough power to fulfill the annual electricity needs of 18 homes!

Avoided 326 Metric Tons of Greenhouse Gas Emissions

Recycling these materials helps create cleaner air!

551,754 Gallons of Water

Represents enough fresh water to meet the daily needs of 7,356 people!
